

## SAFE ROUTES MAPPING SYSTEM

- Under <u>Utah law</u>, every elementary, middle and junior high school is required to create or update a Safe Routes Plan. (see section <u>17 under Utah law</u>)
  - It should be reviewed and approved annually by the Community Council to see if there have been changes to the school attendance boundary, walk zone or the adjacent neighborhoods.
- Districts must review the map and then, once approved, submit to UDOT.

## SAFE ROUTES MAPPING SYSTEM

UDOT has provided a free mapping system to all schools in the state. Using this system allows districts to review, approve and submit to the Utah Department of Transportation automatically. *Note: It is not required to use the Safe Routes Mapping System. See step 6 for submittal process.*

- 1. Logging In
  - a. Go to saferoutesutahmap.com
  - To get a username/password contact the Safe Routes Team at <u>contact@saferoutesutah.com</u> (Use the blue button at the bottom of the page that says "Login with Username and Password")
- 2. Create or Update a School Profile (See page 5 of the Safe Routes Software User Guide)
- 3. Create/Updating a Map (See Safe Routes Mapping Tutorials or Software User Guide)
- 4. Submit a Map
- 5. District Approves Safe Routes Map
  - a. Safe Routes Utah needs contact info for the individual approving safe routes plans/maps in each district.

- 6. District Submits to UDOT
  - a. Using the Safe Routes Mapping System, when a district approves a map, it is automatically sent to UDOT.
  - b. Using another system, the district must send each Safe Routes Plan to Kristen Hoschouer at <a href="mailto:khoschouer@utah.gov">khoschouer@utah.gov</a>.
- 7. Make the Safe Routes Map available to Parents
  - a. Use the link at the bottom of the toolbox and add it to your school website.
  - b. Go to SafeRoutes.Utah.Gov
    - i. Parents can view maps that have been created with the Safe Routes Mapping System.
